 - Bert Frith – Stone walling at Playing Field – The Parish Council expressed their concern over the safety of the wall. He explained that he felt the wall has been built safely and that the Council should have had a health and safety officer inspecting it during the process. The through stones are about every 2m not 90cm as recommended by Peak Park. The meeting moved to the Playing Field to discuss it whilst inspecting the wall. There is no in fill in the wall and you can see through it in parts. The wall is unstable and stones can be removed easily. Bert was asked where he learnt to stone wall and he explained he was self-taught. It was agreed that the options were for him to repair the wall or return the money. It was suggested he thought about this but he thought he would probably return the money. The Clerk will email with these options and await a response. The meeting returned to the Village Hall and the Clerk will obtain quotes to re-wall from the gate down. Clerk
