2. Council Update

Cllr Chris Hornsby updated the meeting on activity for the Parish Council. The Parish Council has had 9 meetings and looked after the maintenance of the Playing Field and Church Car Park. The Council contributed to the village defibrillator. The Church Car Park has been temporarily resurfaced with a view to try and properly resurface in partnership with the Church later in the year. The Council has pruned the trees around the car park. The boundary wall in the playing field has been rebuilt. The Council is supporting Rowsley in trying to sort the parking on Chatsworth Road.
3. Update from St Anne's PCC

Nobody was present but the Clerk updated the meeting that the toilet is finished and well used. The Church roof is in need of repair and the PCC are looking for grants to assist in the repairs.
4. WI Update

Sarah Porter updated the meeting that the WI is small with 16 members but has a varied programme with wine and cheese last month and Tai Chi next month.
5. Village Hall Update

Richard Torr explained that there is a new roof planned which is due to start imminently. This is a metal cladding which will colour down. The main windows have been secondary glazed and the toilets will be done this year. There has been an Awards for All grant to update the hand dryers in the toilets and replace the chairs. Then redecoration will occur. Beeley in Bloom will be over 2 days this year on 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> June. There will be Chesterfield Art Club in the Hall too. There will be a miniature garden competition for the children. The theme is Countries of Europe.
