2. Updates:

Parish Council

The Church Car Park project was updated. The quote for tarmacking was discussed and a suggestion to move the trees to the outside of the car park wall to allow room for more cars. The Parish Council Precept has not gone up in terms of what the Council receives. However, the increase per household reflects the changes in the housing stock of the village; e.g. sole occupancy, empty house and commercial dwellings.

Devonshire Arms

Gill Clempner introduced herself to the village as a new resident who works in the pub as Assistant Manager. She lives in Rose Cottage.

The work on the new pub house is due to start at the end of the month.

Village Hall

- The Christmas Windows were very successful and will look at doing again this year.
- The Hall will be painted this year.
- Open Gardens is planned for 23rd and 24th June. The theme is the end of WW1.
- Children's Christmas Party will be 15th December.
- Easter Egg Hunt will be on Saturday 31st March.

The main project last year was the roof above the vestry which has been completed. They are now looking at repairing the bells and contributing to the Church Car Park repairs.
